

Preschool

We offer a week long day program for children ages 3–5 years old. We use art as the tool to enhance a child’s natural desire to explore.



- Children may attend morning, afternoon, or full-day preschool.
- We hire artists and teachers who respect the creativity and diversity of each child.
- We explore math, science, and literacy through the arts.
- We build sculptures, work in clay, play with paint, bang drums, dance to music, and most of all, have a great deal of fun!
- Our on-site gym and surrounding green spaces ensure lots of time to move our bodies each day.
- We offer a warm, nurturing environment that puts children’s needs first.

Important Things to Know

All students must be potty-trained.

Morning preschoolers must bring a labeled nut-free lunch and snack.

Afternoon preschoolers must bring a labeled nut-free snack.

Mornings: 9:00am – 12:30pm
Afternoons: 1:00pm – 4:30pm
Full Day: 9:00am – 4:30pm
After Care (Mon-Thurs): 4:30pm – 6:00pm

Children who attend both sessions take a quiet time resting break after lunch.

To bring together neighborhood people from diverse cultures by providing creative experiences in the arts with children and families to develop the gifts of self-expression and community.


Our History
